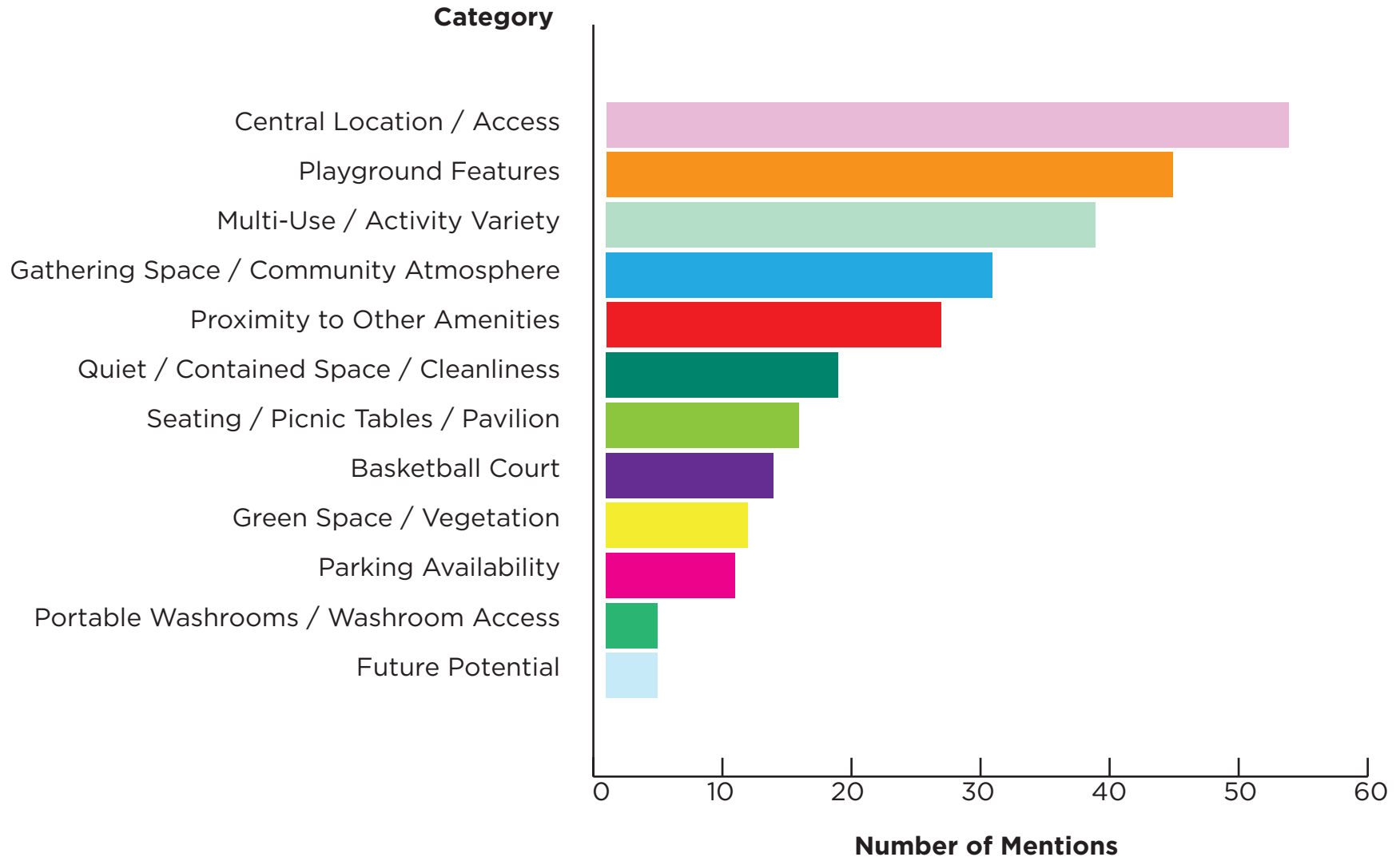

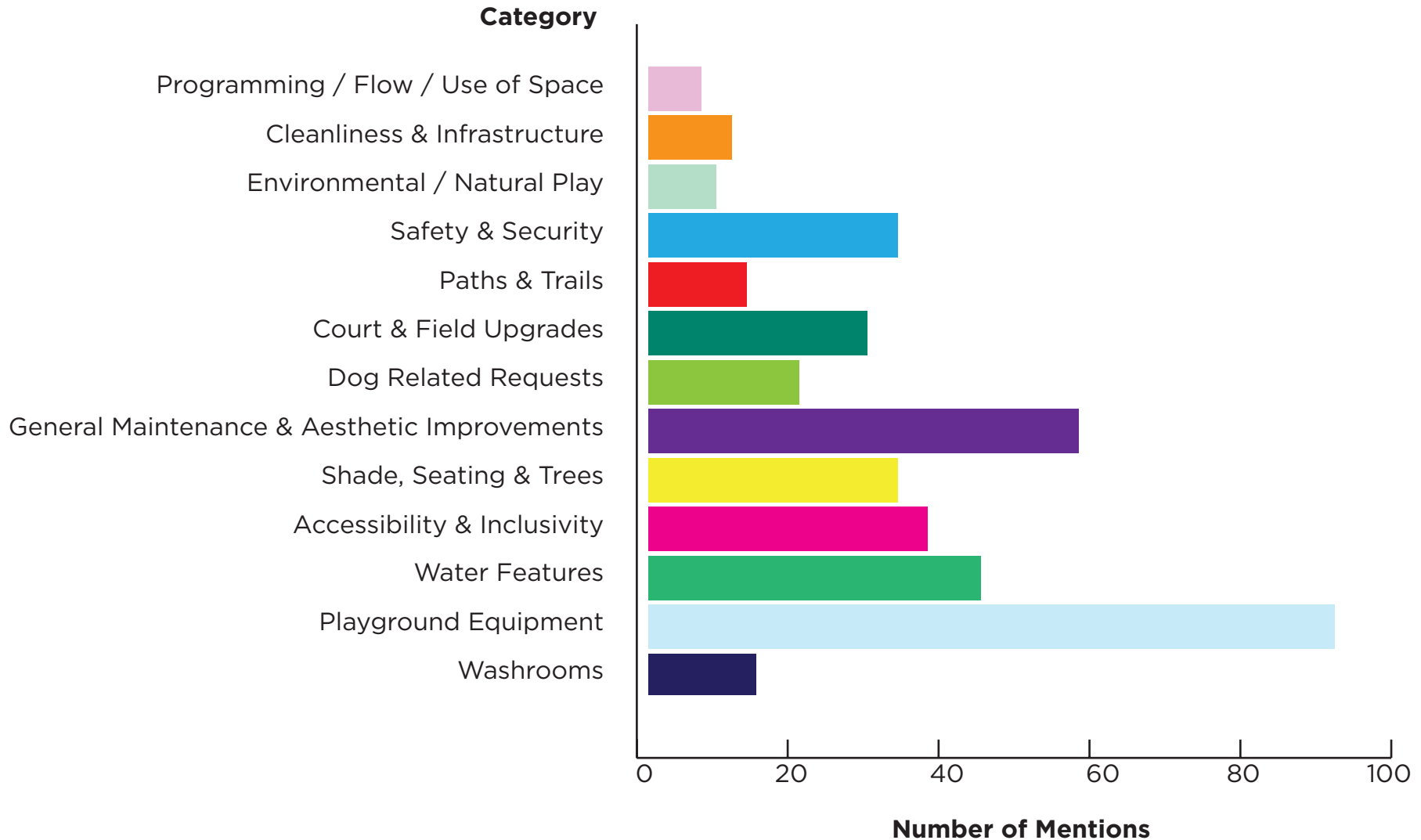

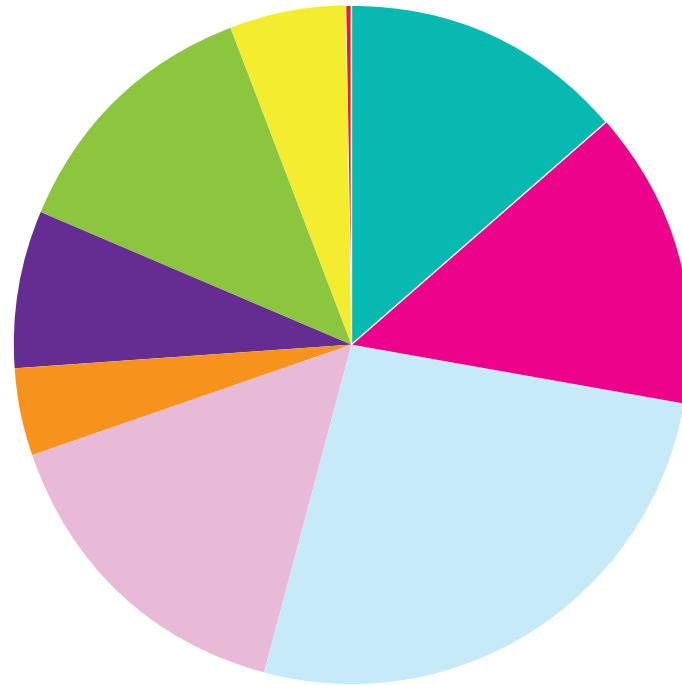

What is your vision for the park in the future?

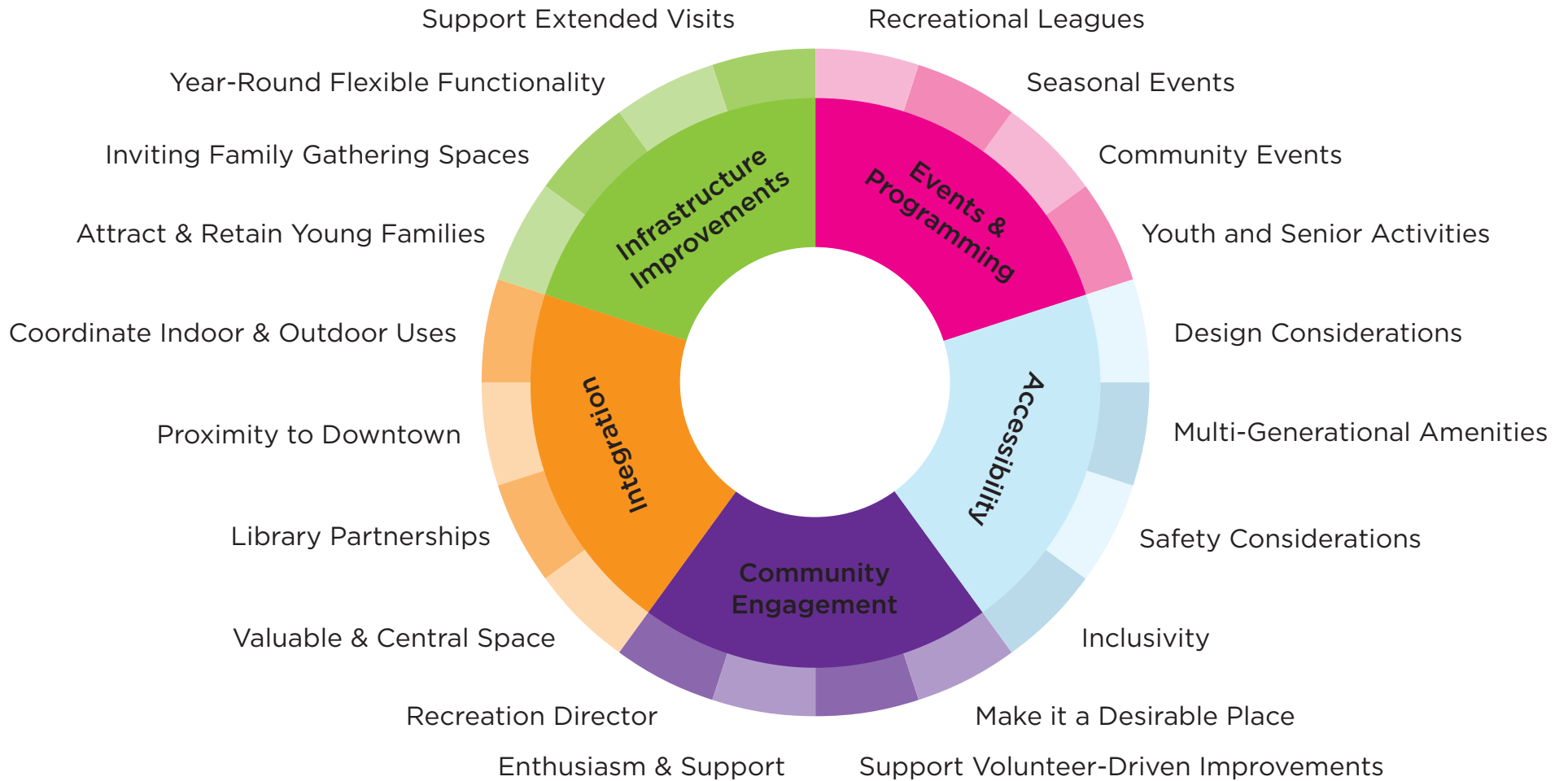
- Community Events - 13.68% or 64 Participants
